Dollar Navigates Tariff Uncertainty as Markets Reassess Outlook

As of April 15th, the U.S. Dollar Index (DXY) made a decline of approximately 4.3% over the past two weeks from its April 1st close of 104.26. This downturn is notable given that tariffs typically bolster the dollar by promoting domestic production and reducing imports. However, the current scenario reflects a shift in investor sentiment, with concerns that President Trump's erratic tariff policies may dampen economic growth and deter foreign investment, leading to a sell-off in U.S. assets. Consequently, investors are gravitating towards traditional safe-haven currencies like the Swiss franc and Japanese yen, as well as gold, which recently reached a new all-time high. Looking ahead, the dollar may remain under pressure if trade uncertainties persist and investor confidence continues to wane.

While recent volatility has weighed on the dollar, continued global demand for U.S. assets, potential stabilization in trade policies and the Fed's data-driven approach could help the greenback regain strength in the coming months.



Apple Rebounds as Tariff Exemptions Ease Investor Fears

Apple Inc. experienced a notable recovery in its stock price following the U.S. government's announcement to temporarily exempt smartphones, laptops, and chips from new tariffs on Chinese imports. This decision alleviated concerns over potential price hikes and supply chain disruptions, leading to a 2.2% increase in Apple's shares on April 14th. Despite this uptick, the stock remains down nearly 12% from its pre-announcement levels, reflecting ongoing investor caution amid trade policy uncertainties. The stock has experienced volatility, with a notable drop from its recent high of \$239.07 on March 7th. This fluctuation underscores the market's sensitivity to trade tensions and policy announcements.

Apple breathes easier for now but continued reliance on Chinese manufacturing and tariffs keep investor on edge.

Nvidia's Strategic Shift to U.S. Manufacturing Amid Tariff Concerns

In a strategic move to align with U.S. policy and preempt potential tariffs, Nvidia announced plans to manufacture AI supercomputers domestically. CEO Jensen Huang emphasized that this initiative would bolster supply chain resilience and meet the surging demand for AI infrastructure. Nvidia aims to produce up to \$500 billion worth of AI infrastructure in the U.S. over the next four years, collaborating with various partners. This move could be a strategic effort to secure favorable treatment amid evolving trade policies. As of April 15th Nvidia's stock closed at \$112.20, reflecting a modest upside of 1.35% from the previous close. The stock has experienced volatility with a notable drop from its recent high of \$114.33 on April 9th. This fluctuation underscores the market's sensitivity to trade tensions and policy announcements.

Nvidia's commitment to U.S. manufacturing positions it favorably amid trade uncertainties, but market volatility may persist as global competition and policy shifts continue to influence investor sentiment.

U.S. Markets Show Resilience Amid Tariff Talks and Shifting Bond Yields

Major U.S. indices settled with the S&P 500 at 5,396.63, Nasdaq at 18,830.23 and the Dow Jones at 40,368.96. Over the past two weeks, the indices have seen considerable downward movement. These moves have been driven by mixed earnings reports, cautious investor sentiment amid ongoing geopolitical tensions and uncertainties over fiscal policy. Recent news points to a cautious yet optimistic outlook for U.S. indices, with forecasts of potential volatility ahead as concerns over inflation and Fed adjustments persist. Treasury yields have risen from 3.5% to 3.7%, reflecting market caution, while the bond market sees modest gains as investors seek safety. Analysts believe robust corporate fundamentals and external pressures will continue shaping market dynamics.

Trump's tariffs are likely to add near-term market volatility, placing downward pressure on investor confidence despite the underlying strength of corporate fundamentals.

Rupee Under Pressure Amid Trade Tensions and Dollar Volatility

The Indian rupee has been under pressure due to global growth concerns and upcoming U.S. tariffs, with investor caution weighing on emerging markets. While a softer dollar provided some relief, hawkish U.S. inflation data and trade uncertainties, including a planned 25% tariff on imported cars from April 3, kept the rupee vulnerable. Fluctuating crude oil prices, foreign fund outflows, and rising U.S. bond yields have further added to the strain. As of April 15, the USD/INR exchange rate stood at 85.72.

Future movements will depend on shifts in U.S. monetary policy, the RBI's forex reserves stance and India's external trade balance amidst geopolitical uncertainties.
